

**DECLARATION OF RICHARD RIESS IN  
SUPPORT OF REQUEST TO MODIFY  
CUSTODY AND VISITATION**

**REQUESTS FOR RELIEF**

I respectfully request this Court grant the following relief:

1. G [redacted] be permitted to choose, for himself, the custody and visitation schedule, and that such visitation be effective immediately.
2. If a hearing in this matter cannot be set prior to G [redacted]'s upcoming Winter Break, that Desiree immediately be ordered to allow G [redacted] to spend his entire Winter Break with me.
3. Desiree immediately return, to G [redacted] or to me, all property which I have provided to him, which she has confiscated and is currently withholding from him, including the mobile telephone which was our only means of free and unmonitored communication.
4. The Court allow independent counsel to represent G [redacted]'s interests in this, and related matters.  
The cost of which shall be shared equally by myself and Desiree.

I, RICHARD RIESS, hereby declare under penalty of perjury that all statements made here are true and

correct to the best of my knowledge.

1. I am the Petitioner in the within action. If called upon as a witness, I could and would testify competently to the following facts, all of which are within my own personal knowledge, except those matters specifically stated on information and belief, and as to those matters, I believe them to be true.
2. I believe G [REDACTED] is mature and responsible enough to be able to decide for himself, with which parent he would like to live, and the terms and conditions of his visitation with the other parent.
3. Although G [REDACTED] has now been in Desiree's care for more than 35 months he has consistently and to this date stated to me, and to the court, that he wishes to return to my care and does not wish to remain in Desiree's care. For that reason, I do not believe it would be in any way harmful to G [REDACTED], psychologically or emotionally, for him to be returned to my care at the earliest possible opportunity.
4. G [REDACTED] has recently told me that he does not consider Desiree and S [REDACTED] (Desiree's other child from another man) family and that he does not feel like he fits in with them or in their home. G [REDACTED] has stated recently that he does not feel a bond with either Desiree or S [REDACTED].
5. G [REDACTED] has recently told me he is "fed up" with Desiree and her way of life, in particular frequently relocating and having to change schools, make new friends, her chronic drug use, and having to live with the different men Desiree enters into relationships with.
6. Since G [REDACTED] has been in Desiree's care, all of his visits with me have been at his discretion, not mine. I always leave the decision to visit up to him and I would never force him to visit with me against his will.

#### **DESIREE'S REFUSAL TO ALLOW VISITATION**

7. During G [REDACTED]'s Spring Break of 2015, Desiree forbid him to visit with me even though he told her he wanted to.
8. During his visit over his Summer Break of 2015, G [REDACTED] wanted to stay with me longer but Desiree forbid him from doing so and demanded he return by July 12<sup>th</sup> even though school did not start until mid-August and there was no other reason he would have to return so early.
9. During G [REDACTED]'s Fall Break of 2015 Desiree refused to allow G [REDACTED] to visit with me, even though he stated he wanted to. Desiree refused to provide a reason or to even respond to my requests for visitation.
10. Although I have submitted multiple written requests to Desiree, for G [REDACTED] to visit with me during his upcoming Winter Break, Desiree has refused to respond to the requests.
11. In September 2015 I was informed by the RCMP that Desiree informed them she had no intention of allowing any further visitation between me and G [REDACTED].
12. In September 2015 Desiree submitted a request to this Court to suspend all further visitation between me and G [REDACTED]. Though, the request was rejected by the Court.
13. I believe the foregoing proves that Desiree has no intention of allowing G [REDACTED] to visit with me, regardless of how it may affect G [REDACTED].

#### **DESIREE'S ATTEMPTS TO ABSCOND WITH G [REDACTED]**

14. In July 2015, while G [REDACTED] was visiting with me, Desiree relocated to another city and refused to inform me of the location where G [REDACTED] would be residing upon his return. She attempt to further conceal her's and G [REDACTED]'s whereabouts by only providing me a USPS mailbox address in another city, 20 miles from her new residence.
15. G [REDACTED] told me Desiree expressly forbid him from informing me that she had moved, where she

had moved to, or the circumstances of their of new living environment.

#### **DESIREE'S INTERFERENCE WITH OUR COMMUNICATION**

16. Upon Gabriel's return to Desiree, in July 2015, Desiree confiscated the mobile telephone I had provided him to facilitate our free and open communication. She has since stated she will not be giving it back to him. This court has expressly forbidden Desiree from interfering with my communication with G [REDACTED], including the telephone I had provided him.
17. G [REDACTED] has recently told me, and Desiree has admitted, that she monitors G [REDACTED]'s telephone calls with me on the landline phone which is my only way of contacting him since she confiscated the mobile phone I had provided him.
18. G [REDACTED] recently told me that Desiree has provided him another mobile phone but he is not allowed to provide me the telephone number and he is not allowed to speak to me on it.
19. G [REDACTED] and Desiree both stated to me that G [REDACTED] is only allowed to speak to me on the landline telephone she monitors, and only in her presence. For that reason, G [REDACTED] and I have been unable to communicate openly since his return to Desiree's care in July 2015.

#### **G [REDACTED]'S FEAR OF REPRISAL FROM DESIREE**

20. G [REDACTED] has stated to me recently, and on numerous occasions, that when he says things which Desiree does not want to hear, she often punishes him and deliberately tries to make him feel bad for it. G [REDACTED] has told me, for that reason he is afraid to tell Desiree what he really wants and to tell her that he doesn't want to live with her.
21. G [REDACTED] has told me that on the drive back to Phoenix, after the hearing in March 2014, when he told this Court that he wished to return to my care, Desiree was very angry with him and tried to make him feel bad for having said that he does not want to live with her.

22. Since my communication with G [REDACTED] is now limited to a telephone which G [REDACTED] and I believe Desiree is monitoring, G [REDACTED] is forced to be very reserved and cautious in his communication with me because he is afraid of being punished by Desiree for saying something which might upset her.

### **DESIREE'S HARMFUL NEGLIGENCE AND INSTABILITY**

23. Over the past 35 months while G [REDACTED] has been in Desiree's care, she has consistently neglected and at times blatantly refused to provide for G [REDACTED]'s medical and dental care.

1. Since January 2013, Desiree has taken G [REDACTED] to the doctor for a non-emergency visit and to the dentist only one time in early 2013.
2. Shortly before G [REDACTED]'s departure from Desiree, to visit with me during his summer break in 2015, Desiree became aware of a staph infection around G [REDACTED]'s left ear and his neck. She refused to bring him to the doctor before he left for his visit. During his visit I brought him to the doctor and began treatment for the infection. Upon his return to Desiree she waited more than a month before getting him medical care to continue the treatment.
3. Providing for G [REDACTED]'s medical and dental care would impose no financial burden on Desiree because I have repeatedly stated I would cover all such expenses and I have provided G [REDACTED] a credit card for such.
4. Desiree refuses to provide a consistent primary care physician for G [REDACTED]. Instead, she takes him to whatever walk-in clinic is most convenient for her at the time. This means the doctor does not have any of G [REDACTED]'s medical history and cannot make informed medical decisions regarding treatment.

24. Since October 2013 I have provided G [REDACTED] a credit card, which I maintain, for the purpose of

facilitating financial support. Both G [REDACTED] and Desiree have been informed, and I have stated in open court, that the card may be used for any support related expenses, including those related to medical care, education, clothing, food, shelter, or transportation. The credit card has a \$4,000 credit limit. I believe it is Desiree alone who refuses to utilize that means of financial support for G [REDACTED] and instead causes G [REDACTED] to go without sufficient medical care, clothing, and other basic needs.

25. For more than 11 months now G [REDACTED] has had a discoloration in the pupil of his right eye, which I have repeatedly informed Desiree of and requested she have it checked by a doctor. She has consistently refused.

26. I believe Desiree has a clear and proven history of rushing into dysfunctional and psychologically harmful relationships with dangerous men who are actively involved in drug use and ongoing criminal activity. And, historically she has demonstrated that she does not take into account the safety and well-being of her children in these matters. In particular:

1. Desiree cohabited with Kristopher Lauchner, who was chronically using crystal methamphetamine in the home while the children were present, and taking the children with him while he engaged in criminal activities such as passing counterfeit currency;
2. Desiree was married to and living with Michael Capuano, who has a long history of domestic violence, for nine years.

During both of those relationships Desiree swore, even to this court, that the respective men were “wonderful, loving, role models” for her children.

27. Desiree recently moved out of the home she was living in, independently, with G [REDACTED] and S [REDACTED], to move in with yet another man she barely knows and has little history with. She has,

again, put her children in a situation where they are all at the mercy of another man who can terminate the relationship and force Desiree and both children onto the street at any moment.

28. Since 2009, Desiree has not resided at one address for more than two years. Each time she has moved, G [REDACTED] was required to transfer to a different school and make new friends. I believe this lifestyle is harmful to children because it precludes them from being able to make significant, long term friendships.

29. I was recently informed that Desiree was recently fired from her job at Apollo Group for using and being under the influence of drugs at work. I believe this, combined with all of the other evidence previously submitted in this matter, proves that Desiree has a serious drug problem which puts G [REDACTED] in constant danger while in her care.

30. When G [REDACTED] arrived for his most recent visit he did not know how to prepare even the simplest of meals, how to buy simple groceries, or how to get around on the public transit. By the end of his six week visit we were regularly cooking meals together, he was riding the public transit on his own, and he would go to the grocery store to buy the items we would prepare for dinner. I believe Desiree has not been teaching G [REDACTED] anything to prepare him for life as an independent adult.

31. During G [REDACTED]'s most recent visit he has told me that he learns and accomplishes more in the short times he spends with me than in the entire two and a half years he has been with Desiree. He has stated that Desiree never takes the time to teach him anything.

#### **DESIREE'S CLAIMS OF FEAR FOR HER SAFETY AND HER CURRENT CREDIBILITY**

32. Over the past two years, Desiree has filed numerous criminal complaints against me with the Phoenix Police Department, the Canadian RCMP, and the Pima County Sheriff's office. The

charges have included uttering threats, criminal harassment, and absconding with G [REDACTED]. In every one of those cases her claims have been determined to be unfounded.

33. As a result of one of the aforementioned criminal complaints I was arrested and questioned by the RCMP, but again, Desiree's allegations were determined to be false and unfounded. The matter was further investigated by the RCMP, the case was referred to the local prosecutor for review, and subsequently dismissed.

34. Desiree has repeatedly attempted to use the fact that I own firearms as a basis to claim she is afraid for her safety. As required by Canadian law, I have undergone an extensive background check to obtain a firearms license and all of my firearms are registered with the RCMP. I believe the fact that the RCMP has not suspended my firearms license or required me to surrender my firearms as a result of Desiree's numerous claims, is proof that they do not consider any of Desiree's claims to be credible and they do not consider me a threat to her or to anyone else.

I believe Desiree has had more than sufficient time to demonstrate that she can be a good parent and act in the best interests of G [REDACTED]. However, I believe over the past two and a half years she has not done a single thing to help G [REDACTED] or improve his quality of life; she has failed to meet even the minimum expectation of a responsible parent; and she continues to put her own selfish desires and the ongoing conflicts between her and I, before the safety and well-being of G [REDACTED].


